PREBID MEETING QUESTIONS AND CLARIFICATIONS

- 1. Contractor is required to provide Geotechnical and Structural services as part of this project. There are specific line items for the geotechnical investigation as well as for final foundation design. The foundations shown on the drawings are to be used for bid pricing. Final design of the foundations will require the final reactions provided by the metal building manufacturer.
- 2. This sludge building and its equipment as well as the digester tank can be taken off line during the period of construction. Bypass pumping will not be required. The Village utilizes Midwest Compost to dewater sludge with a mobile unit approximately three times a year. The Village will coordinate with the contractor the times that Midwest will be brought in so as to provide access to them to the sludge holding tanks to the north of the construction limits.
- 3. It was erroneously stated that the Digester was currently emptied. This is not the case at this time. However, it is the Village's responsibility to have the unit emptied. Once empty the contractor will be allowed to pump residuals to either the head of the plant or sludge drying while cleaning out the unit to allow for the installation of the new aeration system. The bid date has been extended more than a week so as to draw down the sludge enough to provide the contractor access to the floating cover.
- 4. Proposed front entrance gate stated on sheet 4 will be installed by others. This contract will include the proposed power supply to the front gate location.
- 5. WBE and MBE criteria are not absolute percent requirements, however, good faith efforts to provide opportunity for DBEs to participate in the project is required.
- 6. Buy American steel is a required provision for this project but excludes process equipment such as the screw press, conveyor, and pumps. The metal building as well as structural steel, manhole lid and frames will have to meet the provision. - 7. Kirby Building systems has been listed within the specifications other equal building suppliers will be accepted.
- 8. The metal building will require a weatherproof seal where it meets the digester tank.
- 9. It was stated at the meeting that explosion proof requirements are not required in the building. However it was not mentioned that the canopy area will require explosion proof fixtures. This will be addressed in a future addendum.
- 10. Floor tiles in the existing building may contain asbestos and should be removed properly to not avoid being considered friable. Any other Hazardous waste abatement is not known at this time and is not considered part of this contract.

- 11. The demolition of the Oil tank located under the existing garage floor will be the responsibility of the Village to have it removed.
- 12. The Floor drain in the basement of the utility room does not exist. Direct drainage from the equipment shall be routed over to the sump pit located in the pump room. There exists an opening of approximately 6" in diameter between the two rooms at the sump pit.
